"AIG PRESENTS MLB CUP 2017" OPENING CEREMONY HELD IN MIYAGI PREFECTURE

FORMER MAJOR LEAGUER, TAKASHI SAITO, HOSTS BASEBALL CLINIC IN HOME TOWN OF SENDAI

TOKYO, August 2, 2017 – AIG Japan Holdings KK (AIG Japan) held an opening ceremony to mark the commencement of the "AIG presents MLB CUP 2017" in Ishinomaki City, Miyagi Prefecture, on Friday July 28th. To commemorate the start of this year's tournament, AIG also hosted a baseball clinic conducted by former Major League Baseball player Takashi Saito at Kabanomachi Elementary School in Sendai City for young players in the disaster affected region.

AIG Japan has been a supporter of disaster relief efforts in the Tohoku region through various activities including the "Chinjunomori Project" reforestation initiative and various sporting activities. As part of this support "AIG Presents MLB CUP 2017" is an annual Little League baseball tournament first held in 2016. The events of the finals tournament began on Friday 28 July 2017 when 16 Little League baseball teams that had fought their way through qualifying tournaments around Japan gathered in the Ishinomaki Baseball Stadium for the opening ceremony.

Speaking at the ceremony, AIG Japan Holdings President and CEO, Mr. Robert L. Noddin said, "We are very happy to be working with Major League Baseball and the Japan Little League Baseball Association to present a great event where, through sport, young people can learn the importance of health and fitness, how to work in a team, and how to appreciate the strengths of others."



After 2 days of heated competition the team from Tokyo's Musashi-Fuchu League were able to repeat their victory in last year's tournament and were crowned champions for the second year in a row.

In the lead up to the tournament, on the morning of July 28th, former Major League Baseball player, Takashi Saito was the special guest at a baseball clinic conducted for local players in the disaster affected region. Saito, originally from the Wakabayashi area of Sendai, made a special return home for the baseball clinic held for 40 young players from Sendai's Kabanomachi Elementary School and Shichigo Elementary School. Saito led the children through a series of MLB style warm up stretches before instructing the players in batting and other skills. The MLB style stretches for injury prevention reflect AIG Japan's ACTIVE CARE concept and were conducted to help the children learn the importance of preparation and prevention of injuries.

The concept of ACTIVE CARE is AIG Japan's group wide commitment to delivering a total customer experience that helps customers mitigate risk instead of just dealing with the consequences of adverse events.

Takashi Saito, speaking on the importance of preparation before playing sport, said, "It's important to warm up with stretches. It's vital that you don't stretch until it hurts, but listen to your body and only stretch as far as you are comfortable."

After warming up, the children enjoyed their special training session with Saito as he led them through batting practice and other baseball drills.

AIG Japan continues to promote the importance of risk prevention through a wide variety of activities and programs as part of its concept of ACTIVE CARE.
